The Scotch-Brite™ White Floor Pad is a premium quality floor maintenance buffing pad made of polyester fiber in an open-textured, non-woven construction.

Polishing particles are dispersed throughout and bonded to the non-woven construction with a durable resin system that permeates the entire pad.

Unique design and durable construction make these pads the industry standard for consistent performance and long life.

- Designed to be used for spray cleaning or dry buffing of hard surface floors
 - For use on standard, low-speed automatic scrubbers and rotary floor machines (175 - 600 RPM)
- Each floor pad has a pre-cut center hole.



Applications

This product is used for spray cleaning or dry buffing under a rotary floor machine.

It is also used for light scrubbing using water or detergent solutions under standard, low-speed automatic scrubbers.

For use on finish-coated flooring such as sheet vinyl, vinyl tile, marble, terrazzo, or concrete.

Features and Benefits

Uniform coating throughout every 3M™ floor pad reduces the number of knots and clumps, which eliminates scratching of floors while providing greater consistency and extended pad life.

Pads are reversible and will not be significantly affected by water, detergents, or cleaners normally used for floor maintenance.

Exact standards for quality mean thickness uniformity from edge to edge and pad to pad is exceptional, resulting in consistent performance without pad wobble or machine vibration. The precise center-hole placement and roundness of the pads also contribute to the smooth operation, which extends pad life and may help reduce operator fatigue.

Packaging and Marking

Each carton shall be labeled to identify the contents by product name, size, quantity, and manufacturer. Each pad shall be printed with the manufacturer's name.

Standard Sizes

Circular discs and other shapes are available in a variety of common sizes.

Storage

Store indoors in original packaging.

Storage conditions: +4°C to +40°C, out of sunlight, original container in a clean and dry indoor area.

Directions for Use

Note: Floors must be clean, free of soil and in dry condition prior to dry buffing.

1. Install a clean floor pad under the machine pad holder.
2. Dust mop floors before and after spray cleaning or buffing.
3. If floors are heavily soiled, damp mop prior to spray cleaning or buffing.
4. Dust mop prior to scrubbing with an automatic scrubber.
5. Rinse the floor and let it dry prior to opening to traffic.

Maintenance and Cleaning

1. Remove the floor pad from the machine after each use.
2. Wash and rinse under tap water. Avoid dirty pads from drying before washing.
3. Pads may be hosed out using a pressure spray nozzle to remove soil. Pads may be soaked in detergent solution to dissolve caked soil or finished prior to hosing out.
4. Hang up to dry.

Note: Machine-washed floor pads will shrink about 20 mm after the first washing cycle. The recommended washing-machine temperature is 40°C.

Durability

25,000 sqm at 150 RPM in standard use with appropriate maintenance.
